Health Benefits	Cover	age Effective September 1, 2024
Prescription Drug	70%	Overall Plan Maximum of \$2,000 per benefit year. Contraceptives to a maximum \$60 per benefit year; Allergy serums, Insulin injectables, Insulin supplies under pseudo din #910333 to a maximum of \$500 per benefit year, Gardasil Vaccine. Dispensing Fee of \$10.50 applies.
Vision Care	70%	Maximum \$75* for One eye exam; Maximum \$110* for Prescribed lenses/frames/contact lenses/laser eye surgery. *Every 24 consecutive months.
Paramedical Practitioners	70%	Maximum of \$300 per practitioner per benefit year for the following practitioners: Podiatrist*; Acupuncturist (must be registered with the Traditional Council of the College of Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners and Acupuncturists of Ontario); Registered Dietician; Naturopath or Chiropractor; Registered massage therapist*; Physiotherapist*; *Physician's prescription/referral required for indicated services.
Speech Therapist	70%	Maximum of \$1,000 per benefit year for Speech therapist, if recommended by a physician.
Mental Health Practitioners	70%	Maximum of \$800 per benefit year. Clinical psychologist, psychotherapy, Master of Social Work, *No physician referral.
Ambulance	70%	Reasonable and customary charges.
Medical Equipment & Supplies	70%	Including: wheelchairs, walkers, hospital beds, traction kits which are rented for temporary therapeutic use; prosthetic appliances; Vaccines (excluding Hepatitis B), compound serums, colostomy supplies, injectable drugs, and varicose vein injections, if medically necessary.
Life Benefit	-	Maximum \$10,000 Death Benefit.
Outside of Canada	-	Under AD&D, maximum \$10,000 per accident, Accident Death Benefit \$10,000
Other Insurances	-	Tutorial, Nursing Care, under AD&D. mywellness enhanced: 3 hours of counseling sessions.

Dental Benefits Ask your dentist to submit a pre-authorization prior to specialist services and any dental treatment plan exceeding \$500. **Dental Benefits & annual maximum effective September 1, 2024.**

Annual Maximum - \$500 per benefit year

Diagnostic & Preventative	70%	Examination and consultation, including any necessary x-rays and diagnostic services at time of exam, cleaning, and polishing. Limited to 4 units of scaling and 1 fluoride treatment.
Minor Restorative	70%	Fillings.
Oral Surgery	70%	Limited to 2 wisdom teeth per benefit year.
Major Restorative Services, Endodontics, Periodontic	10%	2 additional units of scaling/root planing per benefit year.

The Student Benefits Plan covers supplementary health and dental services and additional benefits not covered by Provincial Health Care and Medical Travel Insurance. In the event of any discrepancy between the information herein and our contract with the insurer, the terms of the contract will apply. All benefits payable through the student plan are based on reasonable and customary charges.

Enrollment Confirmation

All domestic and international students who meet the eligibility criteria are automatically enrolled in the Student Benefits Plan and do not need to apply for coverage.

Review your student account statement and search for the health and dental insurance fees to confirm you are covered by the Student Benefits Plan.

Still unsure if you are enrolled and have coverage? Contact the Benefits Plan Office if you want to know more about your Student Benefits Plan.

Validation Period

There is a 45 day validation period for new enrollments from the start of the term. During this time, you pay out of pocket for all eligible expenses and keep the receipts to submit your claims when the validation period ends.

How To Use Your Student Benefits Plan

- Confirm enrollment.
- Know your benefits.
- Register your account in the Benefits App.
- Update your profile with your address and banking details and download your benefit card.
- Submit claims online to get reimbursed for eligible expenses if your service provider is not set up for direct billing.
